1971 Employed in Fiat was working in the “Special Studies Services.

1972 Moved to Aeritalia, at its founding derived by the merger between Fiat Aviation and Aerfler working in the design team.

1973 Was attending several special school for Program Managing and Control both in Europe and USA (MIT) As a result of this he was given the responsibility of the Project Control Manager of the largest European space Program, Spacelab.

1976 Became Deputy and then Program Manager of the Spacelab project, receiving several Onorary Fellowship by NASA.

1980 Responsible for all the Program Managers of the Aeritalia Space Activities as Program’s Director Taking in particular the role of Program Manager of the Columbus Program.

1988 Was promoted to be Deputy Director of the Space System Group.

1991 At the merger between Aeritalia and Selenia in one single company called Alenia Spazio, he was promoted Deputy General Manager Alenia Spazio

1995 While Alenia Spazio was acquiring larger responsibilities and roles becoming the Prime Contractor of several important international projects (Globastar, Columbus, Artemis, Sicral, Tethered) he was promoted to C.O.O. The international role of Alenia Spazio was confirmed by the participation of Mr. Viriglio as Member of the Board of Loral Space and Communication, and in others specific programs as Globastar, CD Radio, Spacehab, etc.

2000 Appointed CEO and General Director of ALENIA SPAZIO S.p.A

2003 This responsibility has been maintained up to beginning of the present year, when he was appointed As Deputy of the Chairman of the Board with direct responsibility on merger and acquisition, International Space Station policy, Galileo project implementation including alliance and service application and others. Vice CEO of Galileo Industries.
